



## CHAPTER 25 THE TORTURE AT KADIRI








Over the wounds he applied pungent acidic pastes to aggravate the Boy's suffering.



Sathya's tolerance was shocking. It hurt the man's ego.










The Boy simply smiled at the man's failure, passing unscathed through all that terror. The Shakti worshipper was determined to break the Boy's spirit now.





The family watched their little Boy tolerate this torture helplessly.

The family decided to take Sathya away from the mad man immediately.




The sorcerer was

the man give this case up.




Sathya, the all-knowing One, asked the mother to prepare a mixture for His eyes. When she applied it, the swelling receded immediately.
