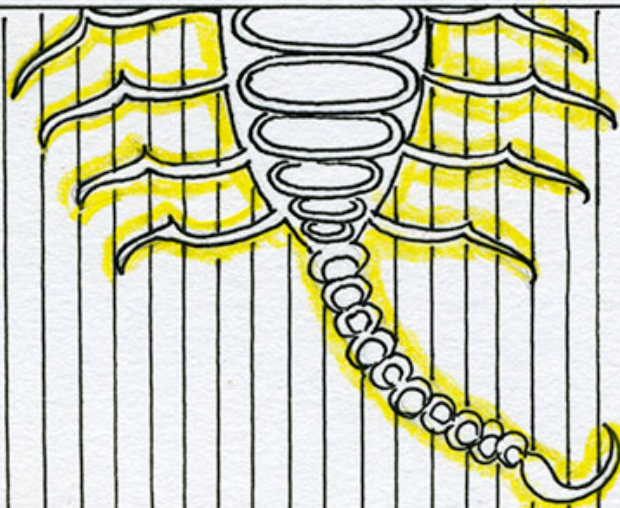


CHAPTER 24 (PART 02)

I'm everything, in everything. You can do nothing, go!

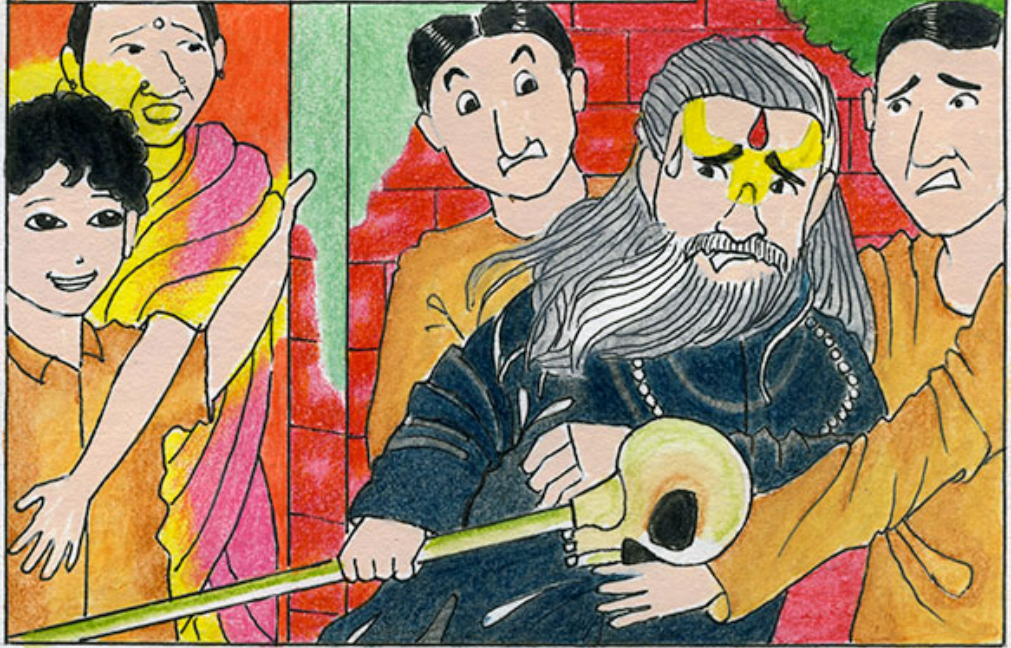
He isn't possessed, He is simply Divine!

At last, they took Sathya to a Muslim man who gave a long list of items to be procured for the procedure.

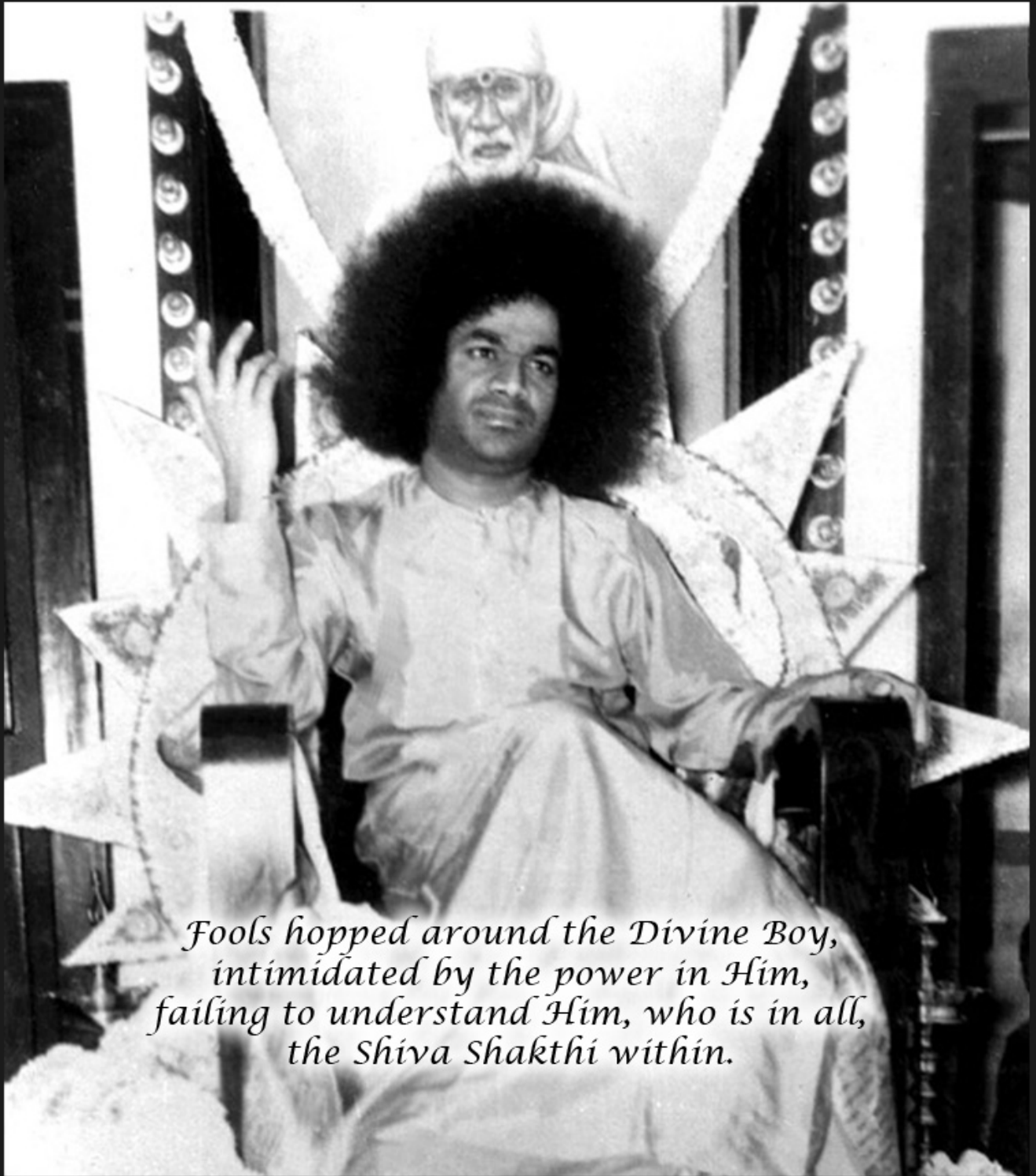


Sathya cornered the man and named an item that he had forgotten to mention.
